Our Programs

Scholarship & Education Advocacy: Opening Doors for Possibilities

Equal opportunity is one of the pillars on which our society is founded. Access to high quality education is one of the ways we achieve it. Yet, for children and youth in the care of the Catholic Children's Aid Society (CCAS) of Toronto, equal opportunity, sometimes seems illusory. Already hurt by neglect and abuse, they struggle to fit into an educational system that often does not provide for their special needs. Our Education Advocate works to find collaborative solutions within the school system and the family to support the learning potential of these children. When they finally succeed against the odds and complete high school, most of these young people face daunting financial barriers to post-secondary education—a necessity in today's knowledge-based economy.



In 2004-2005, 50 young people received financial assistance from the Foundation, half for college and half for university programs. To help ensure that our youth perceive education as a valuable opportunity, our Education Advocate works with more than 600 children in school, helping them find specialized tutoring where necessary, developing educational plans, and working with families and schools to find appropriate solutions to the challenges our children face.

Chetwynd Community Development: Better Outcomes for Children



The Chetwynd Community Development Program is a three-year program for families in Toronto Community Housing neighbourhoods. Chetwynd uses a residential camp setting as a catalyst for community development work. This unique experience brings together people who live in the community and staff who work in community agencies. The aim is to strengthen relationships among residents and between residents and local organizations. Stronger communities are built through the development of the assets of community members. Chetwynd follows a specific program on a yearly basis to facilitate the community development process. This was our last year in the Swansea Mews community and we look forward to our next home in North York.

Pape Adolescent Resource Centre (PARC): 'Ageing-out' Means New Possibilities

We have all doubted ourselves from time to time—wondered if we could succeed at school, keep up the pace at work, or build successful long-term relationships. But for young people in foster care who have seen many broken dreams and blighted hopes, it can be especially hard to believe in themselves and their future. PARC provides young people making the transition from foster care to independent living ('ageing-out') with the gifts of possibility, hope, aspiration and opportunity.

PARC is a partnership between the Catholic Children's Aid Society, the Children's Aid Society of Toronto, and Jewish Family and Children Services.

In 2004-2005, the Foundation financially supported PARC and assisted with its strategic planning process. Additional resources are needed to support a growing number of youth who depend on its services to build a brighter future for themselves. We remain committed to PARC and growing with the program.



Emergency and Enhancement Grants

Many of the children and families served by CCAS live in grinding poverty. These families are faced with limited resources and a sense of despair, resulting in difficult struggles and destitute situations. The Hope For Children Foundation's Emergency and Enhancement Grants program attempts to meet urgent needs and pay for extras that most families take for granted. At the right moment in time, a small grant can turn a life around, stop a downward spiral, give hope, and build self-esteem.



All children deserve the chance to be children. Each year, the Foundation provides hundreds of Emergency & Enhancement Grants. No government funding is available for any of these initiatives, all of which we consider important necessities for the healthy development of children.
